- One dose lasts 6 to 8 hours.
- Do not use ibuprofen in children less than 6 months of age.
- Milliliter is abbreviated as mL
- 5 mL equals 1 teaspoon
- Don't use household teaspoons, which can vary in size
- Do not use aspirin in children.
