

Children's of Alabama - ACE Application Fees

The ACE application process will be open from June 1, 2026-August 3, 2026 for all NEW activities seeking CME credit for 2027. All RENEWAL applications will open from August 31, 2026-November 3, 2026. Complete applications will be reviewed by the ACE department and will be approved or denied at the department's discretion based on volume and complexity. If an activity is approved, the fee associated with it is due within two weeks of being notified that the department can support the activity. Approved applicants who fail to submit the required fee within two weeks will no longer be considered for the calendar year.

Definitions:

Single Offering Activities: Activities that occur once over one or more consecutive days.

Regularly Scheduled Series: A live activity planned as a series with multiple, ongoing sessions, e.g., offered weekly, monthly, or quarterly. An RSS is primarily planned by and presented to the organization's professional staff and generally targets the same audience over the whole series (Grand Rounds, Pediatric Practical Day, and PATHS are excluded and will be supported at no fee).

MOC: Part 2: Lifelong Learning and Self-Assessment (Part 2) of Maintenance of Certification (MOC) is designed to help pediatricians assess and enhance the clinical knowledge and skills important to their individual practices, using activities developed by the American Board of Pediatrics (ABP) and other organizations.

Conference: A live CME activity where the learner participates in person lasting one to two days in the COA vicinity or surrounding area. The activity includes multiple speakers and may have commercial vendors. No International Conference applications will be accepted or processed by COA's ACE office. Examples: annual meeting, multi-day activity, seminar. *After review of the application and the scope of work involved, an additional fee may be charged.
