From File to Fruition

The Adoption Clinic at UAB has been changing lives for 20 years



Many would say a dose of stress comes along with the miraculous adventure of becoming a parent. Sarah and Jasper Cornett first entered parenthood when they welcomed a daughter through Lifeline Children's Services' domestic adoption program in 1996. In 2003, they grew their family again when they flew from Birmingham, Alabama to Beijing, then on to Nanchang, China to adopt a 15-month-old child. The Adoption Clinic, a nonprofit located at UAB's Children's South, is staffed with professionals with a love for children who have been orphaned and a desire to see them in loving, well-equipped families. Throughout its 20 years, the clinic has been a Birmingham gem and a vital resource—a "village" that families like the Cornetts cannot fathom life without.
